<p>Pre-Free Skate and Free Skate: Each free skate level is comprised of a variety of progressive skating skills, transitions, spins and jumps — all of which build on the previous skill, providing skaters a strong foundation of all elements. Recommended for advanced basic skills skaters level 6 and up. This class includes a 45-minute lesson (6:00-6:45 p.m.) and practice ice time (6:45-7:00 p.m.). This is our bridge program, which is designed to introduce basic skills level skaters to the free skate level of skating. The class is taught in a positive and interactive group format.</p> <p>Required: AFSC Introductory club, full club (been a prior full member of USFS), or associate club membership. Skater's need to be a member of USFS to skate during this ice time for insurance purposes.</p> <p>No refunds: There are no refunds with package purchases except as described in AFSC policy.</p> <p>No Make-ups: Please choose a package that fits with your schedule. You may choose which weeks to miss.</p> <p>Supervisors: Each session of ice must have a Supervisor, responsible for checking in skaters, collecting money, playing music, completing accident forms when necessary, and ensuring use of fleece belts by skaters for safety purposes.</p> <p>Medical Waivers - All skaters, including buy-on purchasers, must have a current Authorization for Medical Treatment waiver on file (forms are available at the rink from the session supervisor).</p> <p>All Skaters: Must check in with supervisor prior to entering the ice; must be courteous and considerate while on the ice; and yield to skaters wearing the fleece belts skating to their music.</p>

Briefly, supervisor's check-in package purchasers, make sure belts and cd player are at the ice, play music as requested and collect money for buy-on purchases. To the extent possible, we work to accommodate all schedules. In order to help us do that, please indicate which 1-hour timeslot for the session you are purchasing is the best for you to supervise. Choosing which hour does not mean you will have to supervise every session (we sincerely appreciate anyone who volunteers to cover most, if not all dates) but lets us best accommodate your schedule. **We depend on volunteers to make these sessions a success.**

In years, past (including last year), there have been people who generously volunteered to supervise the entire session. If they were not available for a day or two we would find a replacement. We would be most appreciative if someone (or a couple someone's) would be willing to pick up that practice again, particularly if you are going to be there most of the time anyway.
