Season Details

We are looking to field three teams for the 2019-2020 season:

- Synchro Skills Exhibition (show) or Competitive
 - o A team of 8-16 skaters. Ages 5 to 13.
 - Skating Levels: Basic Skills 2-6, Free Skate. No skaters may have passed higher than a preliminary test.
 - If a competitive team, 3 competitions to be determined.
- Open-Juvenile Competitive
 - o A team of 8-16 skaters. All skaters under age 20.
 - All skaters must have passed the pre-preliminary moves in the field test.
 - 3 competitions to be determined
- Open Adult Competitive
 - A team or 8-16 skaters. The majority of the team must be 19 years or older.
 - o 3 competitions to be determined

The season will start August 22, 2019 and end mid-March 2020. Practices will be Thursdays from 5:45-6:45 p.m. starting August 22nd and will switch to Saturday afternoons in mid-October, additional practices maybe added around competitions dates. Practices typically range from 1-hour to 1 ½ hours, a minimum of one day per week. Skaters should continue their skating lessons either group or private throughout the season so they continue to work on and build their skating skills.

Depending on the number of skaters the per skater total could change as some costs would be spread out among more skaters. Monthly payments are collected per skater throughout the season. There is a \$150 non-refundable commitment deposit required to secure placement on a team. The team will also have fundraisers to help offset costs.
